MA in Environment and Development

Jadavpur University Offers a Masters Degree Course via online web based distance-learning mode

The MA in Environment and Development offers an Open and Distance Learning Environment using Computer Aided Learning materials including Multimedia and Web-based packages along with workshops to develop advanced knowledge, skills and understanding in the study.

Eligibility

Honors/Major graduate in any discipline or Technical/ Professional degree (with completed result only) from a recognized Indian University. Preference will be given to persons with relevant work experience of at least two years. Competence in English, computer literacy and access to computer and Internet facilities are required. By taking this course the student can study alongside regular employment to enhance his/her career prospects, develop his/her skills, knowledge and research expertise or upgrade his/her existing commitment to environment and developmental concerns.

Evaluation

A part of the evaluation for each paper (40%) will be through on-line submission of graded tasks. The rest (60%) in each paper will comprise of examinations held in Jadavpur University, twice a year.

Structure of the course

Two/ three papers will be offered in a semester. Duration of the course is two

years (4 semesters). The papers for this Masters course are shown below.

History

Founded in 1955, Jadavpur University has been identified by the Universities Grants Commission as one of the 'Universities with Potential for Excellence' in India. This is a high quality course, making use of a Web-based learning environment and online tutorials as well as more traditional learning resources.

Manner of Study

Most of your study will involve working in your own time following a structured programme of work laid out in a 'virtual learning environment' accessed over the Internet. You will not be studying alone, however, and will communicate using email, discussion boards and online seminars. Interaction with tutors and fellow students is encouraged. You will also meet face-to-face with your instructors in workshops held each year, in April and September, at Jadavpur University. You will be expected to travel to Jadavpur University at your own cost and make your own arrangement for stay in Kolkata.
