Mizoram University is a Central University being set up on modern standards with excellent academic infrastructure and research facilities including a Central Analytical and Preparatory Facility consisting of sophisticated equipments. Mizoram is one of the most peaceful states in the country despite being located in the NER. Aizawl is connected by Air from Kolkatta and Guwahati (daily flights). Nearest railhead is at Silchar (180 km). The climate is mild both in summer and winter.

Teachers are provided hard furnished housing and Special Duty Allowance of 12.5% of Basic Pay + AGP besides all other Central allowances and NER concessions. A Kendriya Vidyalaya has been set up for education of the children of employees.

Applications are invited for filling up of vacant Teaching and Group ‘A’ Non-teaching posts under the University as tabled vide **Annexure - I**.

Complete application as per the prescribed format appearing at **Annexure – II(a) for Teaching, Assistant Librarian and Librarian posts and Annexure – II(b) for other Non-teaching posts** along with application fee of ₹ 500.00 in the form of Bank Draft drawn in favour of Registrar, Mizoram University on State Bank of India, Aizawl Main Branch may be submitted to the **Deputy Registrar, Administration-I, Recruitment Cell, Mizoram University, Post Box No.190, Aizawl, Mizoram - 796 004**.

SCs, STs and Persons with Disabilities are fully exempted from payment of the prescribed fees upon submission of relevant Caste / Tribe / Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority. Women applicants are also fully exempted from payment of the prescribed fees.

The Application form along with the required Datasheet/Academic Performance Indicators (API) score sheet/Scoring Scheme for filling up API Score sheet may be downloaded from MZU website, www.mzu.edu.in in A-4 size paper. The same may also be obtained from **Recruitment Cell, Administration-I, Mizoram University** by paying ₹ 50.00.

i) Applicants, in their own interest, are advised to go through the terms and conditions of the advertisement. The completeness of the submitted applications is the sole responsibility of the applicant.

- ii) The University reserves the right not to fill any of the post(s). There may be an increase or decrease in the number of posts advertised.
- iii) Applications should be **supported by relevant documents (attested)** in all respects including for Datasheet and API Score sheet. Applications not supported by documents will be summarily rejected.
- iv) Applications for the posts reserved for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes should be supported by the Caste/Tribe certificate in a GOI prescribed format duly issued by the competent authority. Applications for posts reserved for Persons with Disabilities should be supported by appropriate Medical Certificate duly issued by the authorized Medical Board. Applicants for the reserved post of OBC are required to submit a certificate regarding his/her **'OBC status and non-creamy layer status'** in a prescribed format duly issued on or after **13.01.2012** by the competent authority. Relaxations and concessions will apply as per GOI Reservation rules.

D.1 ARTS, HUMANITIES, SCIENCES, SOCIAL SCIENCES, COMMERCE, EDUCATION, LANGUAGES AND MASS COMMUNICATION:

1. Assistant Professor:

- (i) Good academic record with at least 55 % marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- (iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) above, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- (iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmers in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

2. Associate Professor:

- (i) Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- (ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55 % marks (or equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- (iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) A minimum consolidated score requirement of 300 points from Category III of the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS)

3. Professor:

- (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum consolidated score requirement of 400 points from Category III of the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS).

OR

An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

Note: The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil and/or Ph.D degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience.

D.2 ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY DISCIPLINE:

1. Assistant Professor

i) Essential:

First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech).

ii) Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:

- 1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
- 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals

2. Associate Professor

i. Essential:

A Ph.D. Degree with First Class at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engg., & Tech., **and** experience of eight years in teaching, research and / or industry at the level of Lecturer or equivalent grade, excluding period spent on obtaining the research degree.

OR

ii. In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as essential:

1. First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engg. & Tech.;
2. Significant professional work which can be recognized as equivalent to a Ph.D. Degree in appropriate branch of Engg., & Tech., and industrial / professional experience of eight years in a position equivalent to the level of Lecturer,

Provided that the recognition for significant professional shall be valid only if the same is recommended unanimously by a 3-Member Committee of Experts appointed by the Vice-Chancellor of the University.

iii. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:

1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
2. Published work, such as research papers, patents filed / obtained, books, and / or technical reports.
3. Experience of guiding the project work / dissertation of PG / Research Students or supervising R&D projects in industry.

3. Professor:

i. Essential:

1. A Ph.D. Degree with First Class at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engg. & Tech., and experience of ten years in teaching, research and / or industry, out of which at least five years at the level of Reader or equivalent grade.

OR

ii. In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as essential:

1. First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engg. & Tech.:
2. Significant professional work which can be recognized as equivalent to a Ph.D. Degree in appropriate branch of Engg. & Tech., **and** industrial / professional experience of ten years, out of which at least five years at a senior level of Assistant Professor / Reader,

Provided that the recognition for significant professional shall be valid only if the same is recommended unanimously by a 3-Member Committee of Experts appointed by the Vice-Chancellor of the University.

iii. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:

1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
2. Published work, such as research papers, patents filed / obtained, books, and / or technical reports;
3. Experience of guiding the project work / dissertation of PG / Research Students or supervising R&D projects in industry;
4. Demonstrated leadership in planning and organizing academic, research, industrial and / or professional activities; and
5. Capacity to undertake / lead sponsored R&D, consultancy and related activities.

D.3 MANAGEMENT / BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION:

Professor:

- i. Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant discipline or consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by the AICTE / UGC;

OR

First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant / Cost and works Accountant / Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

- ii. Ph.D. or Fellow of Indian Institute of Management or of an Institute recognized by AICTE and declared equivalent by the AIU.
- iii. A minimum of ten years' experience of teaching / industry / research / professional out of which five years must be at the level of Reader or equivalent excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degree.

OR

- iv. In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as essential:
 - 1. Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in two years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by the AICTE / UGC.

OR

First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant / Cost and works Accountant / Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

- 2. The candidate should have professional work experience which is significant and can be recognized at national / International level as equivalent to Ph.D. and twelve years' managerial experience in industry / profession of which at least eight years should be at least at a level comparable to that of Reader/Assistant Professor.

 - i) Teaching, research, and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
 - ii) Published work, such as research papers, patents file/ obtained, books and / or technical reports;

 - v) Capacity to undertake / lead sponsored R&D consultancy and related activities.
