1. Applications in the prescribed form are invited from the candidates having requisite qualification, from a recognized Medical College for recruitment to the posts of Professors and Associate Professors in different disciplines in the Govt. Medical Colleges of the State under Group-A of the Odisha Medical Education Service in the Pay Scale of ₹ 37,400 - 67,000/- + AGP ₹ 10,000/- for Professor & Pay Scale of ₹ 37,400 - 67,000/- + AGP ₹ 9,000/- for Associate Professor along with usual allowances as sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time.

4. <u>AGE:</u> The maximum upper age limit shall be 55 years in respect of Professors and 50 years in respect of Associate Professors as on 1^{st} August, 2011.

The date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent Certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Commission.

5. <u>OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS</u>:

- (i) The candidate must be a citizen of India;
- (ii) The candidate must be of (a) good moral character, and (b) sound physical and mental health, good physique and active habits and free from organic defects or bodily infirmities so as not to create an impairment in the due discharge of duties;
- (iii) He/She must be able to speak, read and write Odia fluently and must have passed: at least an examination in Odia language equivalent to that of Middle English School Standard conducted by the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha ; or the Education Department of Govt. of Odisha or any other Board or Council of Secondary Education approved by the Government of Odisha in support of passing of Odia Language Test (M.E. School standard);
- (iv) A person, who has more than one spouse living or in case of a woman candidate, if married to a person having one spouse living, shall not be eligible for appearing at the examination/interview:

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person or there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule;

- (v) Government servants, whether temporary or permanent, are eligible to apply provided that they possess the requisite qualification and experience and are within the prescribed agelimit as provided under Para-3 of this advertisement. <u>They must inform their respective</u> <u>Head of Offices in writing regarding submission of their applications for this</u> <u>recruitment and obtain "No Objection Certificate"</u>;
- (vi) If a candidate has at any time, been <u>debarred for a certain period</u>/chance(s) by the Odisha Public Service Commission or other State Public Service Commission or U.P.S.C. from appearing at any examination/interview, he/she will not be eligible for such recruitment for that specified period/chance(s);

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- (vii) Only those candidates, who fulfill the requisite qualification & experience and are within the prescribed age limit etc. by the closing date of receipt of applications, will be considered eligible;
- (viii) Before appointment, a candidate must register himself/herself under the Odisha Medical Registration Act, 1961;

6. <u>OTHER CONDITIONS:</u>

(i) A candidate found guilty of seeking support for his/her candidature by offering illegal gratification or applying pressure on any person connected with the conduct of the recruitment process or found indulging in any type of malpractice in course of the selection or otherwise, shall, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be disqualified not only for the recruitment for which he/she is a candidate, but also may be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any recruitment or selection to be conducted by the Commission;

(ii) <u>Applications found to be incomplete in any respect are liable to rejection without entertaining any correspondence with the applicants on that score;</u>

- (iii) Admission to viva voce will be **provisional.** If on verification at any stage before or after the viva voce, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil all the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be liable to rejection. Decision of the Commission in regard to eligibility or otherwise of candidate shall be final;
- (iv) This advertisement should not be construed as binding on the Government to make appointment;
- (v) Candidates are required to take due care to annex with the applications, the copies of certificates and other documents as stated under Para-7 of this advertisement and mention the total number of the annexed documents at the appropriate place of Annexure-I of the application form;
- (vi) The posts are temporary, but likely to be made permanent. The appointment can be terminated on one month's notice from either side without assigning any reason thereof;
- (vii) Candidates are required to mention name of the discipline clearly while mentioning the name of Post/Service on the front page of the prescribed application form. If a candidate wants to apply for more than one discipline, he/she should apply in separate application forms along with separate fees and other required documents as per the provisions made in the advertisement;
- (viii) Mere empanelment in the select list shall not confer any right for appointment unless the Government is satisfied after making such enquiry as may be deemed necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the Service;
- (ix) All persons appointed under Government of Odisha on or after 1st January, 2005 shall not be eligible for pension as defined under sub-rule(1) of Rule-3 of the Odisha Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1992; but shall be covered by the defined contribution pension scheme in accordance with the Odisha Civil Service (Pension) Amendment Rules, 2005.

7. <u>CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED</u>: Candidates are required to submit along with their applications, **true copies of the following documents duly attested by the candidate or Gazetted Officer or Notary Public. The candidates are also required to mention on each document** "<u>submitted by me</u>" and put their full signature on the same. They must <u>not attach</u> original certificates to their applications. Only those who are called for the Viva Voce will be required to bring with them, the Original Certificates and Mark-Sheets etc. of the attested copies, for verification at the time of Viva Voce.

If a candidate fails to furnish any of the original documents in respect of the attested copies submitted with the application for verification on the date of interview before the interview starts, he/she shall not be allowed to appear at the interview.

- (i) H.S.C. or equivalent certificate in support of declaration of age issued by the concerned Board/Council;
- (ii) Intermediate/+2 examination certificate issued by the concerned University/Council;
- (iii) M.B.B.S. Degree Certificate issued by the recognized University;
- P.G. Degree Certificate in support of qualification in the concerned Speciality/higher speciality issued by the concerned University/Institution recognized by the Medical Council of India;
- (v) Mark-lists in support of all the aforesaid examinations (i.e. H.S.C. to M.B.B.S.) passed including fail marks, if any, issued by the concerned Board/Council/ University;
- **NOTE**: (a) Candidates who have not been awarded percentage of marks, but only "GRADE MARKS", should, along with their applications, produce the Conversion Certificate from the concerned University including the actual equivalent percentage of marks and the conversion formula, failing which, their applications are liable to be rejected.
 - (b) While filling up the table under Sl. no. 5 & 6 of Column no.15 of the application form, the candidate has to mention details of marks secured in each semester/annual examination leading to award of the degree.
- (vi) List of marks obtained at the M.B.B.S. Degree examination (from first to final) indicating the **chances taken** to obtain the degree, issued by the concerned University;
- (vii) Houseman-ship completion certificate;
- (viii) Medical registration certificate;
- (ix) Certificate from the Head of the Institution/Head of the Department regarding satisfactory performance during last three years;
- (x) Required odia pass certificate from the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha indicating Odia as a language subject equivalent to M.E. School Standard or a certificate from the Principal/Headmaster of the School indicating that the candidate has passed Odia in M.E. Standard;
- (xi) Certificate relating to passing of the screening test conducted by the National Board of Examination as prescribed by the Medical Council of India vide Notification No.MCI-203(9) Regn. 2001, dated 13.02.2002 for medical graduate passing out of a foreign university;

- (xii) If a candidate claims to possess qualification, equivalent to the prescribed qualification, the rule/authority (with number and date) under which it is so treated, must be furnished with the application;
- (xiii) Three recent passport size photographs signed by the candidates on the front of the photographs, one pasted at the right hand corner of the first page of the application and the other two stitched to the application.
- (xiv) Certificates of character and conduct from the Principal/ Proctor/ Dean or Professor in charge of a Department of Teaching of the College or University in which he/she last studied;
- (xv) Acknowledgement Card (supplied by O.P.S.C.) mentioning particulars of present postal address, application form no., advertisement no. etc. and affixing stamp of ₹.6/-. (Selfaddressed Post Card with stamp of ₹.6/- in case of candidates downloading the application form from the website of the O.P.S.C.);
- (xvi) One self-addressed envelope (Approximately 23 Cm. X 10 Cm.).

8. <u>METHOD OF SELECTION</u>: The selection of candidates for recruitment to the posts shall be made with due regard to the candidates' academic attainment, teaching experience, aptitude, ability to teach, Performance Appraisal Report and such other modalities **as may be decided by the Commission**. The Commission, at their discretion, may short-list the candidates to a reasonable number, for conducting interview by making a preliminary selection either on the basis of evaluation of their academic career taking into account the requisite minimum educational qualification or by conducting a preliminary written test.

9. <u>HOW TO APPLY</u>: (i) Application Form : Candidates are required to apply to the Special Secretary to the Commission in the prescribed form which, along with other particulars, are obtainable in person from the Office of the Special Secretary, Odisha Public Service Commission, 19, Dr. P.K. Parija Road, Cuttack-753001 between 11.00 A.M. & 1.30 P.M. and 2.00 P.M. & 4.00 P.M. on any working day on cash payment of ₹.50/- for candidates belonging to S.C./ S.T. category & ₹ 150/- for other categories. by Speed Post/Registered Post on remittance of ₹ 90/- for S.C./ S.T. candidates & ₹.190/- for other categories by Bank Draft/Pay Order drawn in favour of Special Secretary, Odisha Public Service Commission payable at any Scheduled Bank at Cuttack with a forwarding letter addressed to the Special Secretary, O.P.S.C., Cuttack mentioning full name and address of the candidate, advertisement number and name of the Post/Service advertised in **BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS**.

(ii) If the letter along with Bank draft/Bank Pay Order from any candidate for supply of prescribed application form is received in the office of the O.P.S.C. after the last date for receipt of applications, no application form will be supplied to such candidate;

(iii) The candidates may also download the prescribed application form and copy of long advertisement from the Website of the O.P.S.C., i.e. <u>http://opsc.nic.in</u>. The Un-reserved and S.E.B.C. candidates downloading the application form will be required to pay ₹.150/- only in shape of Bank Draft/Bank Pay Order / or Treasury Chalan (deposited under the <u>Head "0051-P.S.C.-105-State P.S.C.- Examination Fee</u>"), at the time of submission of their applications. The S.C./S.T. candidates downloading the prescribed application form will be required to pay ₹.50/- in shape of Bank Draft/Bank Pay Order or Treasury Chalan (deposited under the <u>Head "0051-P.S.C.- Examination Fee</u>"), as the case may be, at the time of submission of their applications.

(iv) The candidates are required to enclose the Original Money Receipt/Bank Draft/ Bank Pay Order /Treasury Chalan, as the case may be, at the time of submission of their applications, failing which the candidature of the concerned candidate will be summarily rejected, without giving any further notice. <u>No separate examination fee is required to be paid by any candidate.</u>

(v) **Submission of Applications:** Candidates are required to send their applications in prescribed form by Registered Post/Speed post/Courier service to the Special Secretary, Odisha Public Service Commission, 19, Dr. P.K. Parija Road, Cuttack-753001. The Commission will not take any responsibility if the application is not received in time. The candidates may also submit their applications in closed covers in the Office of Odisha Public Service Commission directly/personally on or before the last date of receipt of applications at the counter. The closed envelope containing the application "Application posts of **Professors/Associate** be superscribed for the Professor must in(discipline to be mentioned)". The candidates submitting their applications directly/personally at the counter of Odisha Public Service Commission will be given proper acknowledgement receipt;

(vi) Applications received after the closing date shall not be entertained.

10. <u>ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF APPLICATIONS</u>: On receipt of application of a candidate, the Acknowledgement Card (self addressed Post Card in case of downloaded application form) submitted by him/her along with the Application, will be despatched to him/her by the Commission's office. The mere fact that a candidate's application has been acknowledged by the Commission does not mean that his/her candidature for the recruitment has been accepted by the Commission.
