Admission Intimation Memo for **Arts Courses** for the Academic Year 2010-11in Andhra University, Visakhapatnam, Dr. B.R.Ambedkar University Srikakulam, Etcherla and Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajahmundry

Admissions will be made for different courses offered by the above Three Universities at a common counseling session being held in Andhra University as per the admission schedule.

All the candidates, who were awarded a rank in AURPGCET-2010 and received this call letter, are directed to report at <u>Sir C.R. Reddy Convocation Hall, Andhra University, Visakhapatnam</u> on the date and time specified in the Admission Schedule (page 3) along with the following original documents/ certificates.

- 2. Rank card issued by the Convener, AURPGCET-2010
- 3. Hall ticket issued by the Convener, AURPGCET-2010
- 4. Statements of Marks and Provisional Certificate / Original Degree
- 5. Transfer and Conduct Certificate from the institution where the candidate last studied.
- 6. Study Certificates from IX standard onwards issued by the Heads of the respective institutes **OR** Local Candidate Certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format.
- 7. Date of birth certificate (S.S.C. or equivalent).
- 8. Integrated Community Certificate issued by competent authority in case of SC/ST/LBC candidates.
- 9. Latest Income Certificate issued by the competent authority (within 12 months) in case of eligible SC/ST/LBC/EBC candidates claiming fee concession.
- 10. Certificate in prescribed form in respect of claim under special category (CAP / NCC / PH / SPORTS / NSS) where ever applicable.
- 11. Migration Certificate in case of candidates from Universities other than the University where the admission is sought.
- 12. Physical fitness certificate from the Medical Officer, Andhra University or from a Govt. Assistant Civil Surgeon.
- 13. Four recent passport size photos.
- 14. A set of attested copies of all the above certificates/documents.

General Information (Part-I):

- Admission will be made according to the rank obtained in the concerned test in AURPGCET-2010, as per the rules noted
 in the Admission Information Brochure-2010 and the distribution of seats for different categories in various P.G. Courses
 offered by A.U. and its Affiliated colleges, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University, Srikakulam, Etcherla and its Affiliated Colleges,
 Aadikavi Nannaya University, Rajahmundry. See Andhra University Website www.andhrauniversity.info/doa/index.html for
 further details.
- Candidate seeking admission into a particular course should fulfill all the requisite eligibility criteria as specified in the admission information brochure of AURPGCET-2010. Such of those candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria and do not have all the relevant certificates will not be permitted for counseling. <u>Candidates passed in Instant Examination of 2010 are also eligible for admission</u>. <u>Candidates</u> passed in advanced supplementary / supplementary examinations of 2010 are not eligible for admission.
- 3. A counseling fee of Rs. 500/- in the form of DD will be collected from all candidates (Rs. 250/- for SC & ST Candidates) drawn in favour of Director, Directorate of Admissions payable at Visakhapatnam. Candidates can pay the same at the bank counter located in the counseling centre and produce the receipt before entering the counseling Hall.
- 4. Candidates have to submit Demand Draft(s) drawn in favour of "Admission account, Directorate of Admissions" payable at Visakhapatnam from any nationalised bank towards the prescribed course fee along with all the certificates. The details of course fee will be placed on the Andhra University web site shortly www.andhrauniversity.info/doa/index.html.
- 5. All certificates related to reservation categories like SC, ST, LBC etc. are subject to scrutiny by appropriate Government agencies.
- 6. Candidates seeking admission under Sports, PH, NCC, CAP, NSS are directed to appear before admission committee along with all original certificates in support of the claim for verification by the Committee. The admissions are based on the priorities fixed by the panel of experts and subject to availability of seats in the particular course / college, as per the rules mentioned in Admission Information Brochure AURPGCET-2010. Only local candidates are eligible for admission under NCC, PH, CAP, NSS and Sports categories.
- 7. Sliding is allowed only in second phase from course to course of the same test and college to college on the basis of availability of seats. A candidate can avail sliding only once. A nominal amount of Rs.300/- has to be paid towards sliding charges.
- 8. NO EXTENSION OF TIME EITHER FOR PRODUCING CERTIFICATES OR FOR PAYMENT OF FEE SHALL BE GRANTED AND NO CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERTAINED IN THIS REGARD.
- 9. Cancellation of admission will be made as per the following refund policy:
- a) 90% of the total fee -up to the end of 1st phase of counseling.; b) 80% of the total fee -up to the end of 2nd phase of counseling.; c) No refund after 2nd phase of counseling.

General Information (Part-II):

- 1. The admission process is likely to continue up to late hours and in some cases for the next day. The candidates should come prepared to stay for one or two days if required.
- 2. Admission of a candidate is purely provisional. The concerned University reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage. Candidates getting admission by producing false information / fake certificates are liable for prosecution. Their seats will be cancelled without any notice on the detection of fraud at any time during their course of study.
- 3. Admission is liable to be cancelled, if the student does not put in continuous attendance for a period of 10 days without valid reason from the date of commencement of the classes.
- 4. SC/ST/LBC/EBC candidates seeking admission into P.G. courses and whose parental / guardian annual income is less than Rs.1,00,000/ are eligible for the sanction of course fee by the Department of Social / Tribal Welfare, Andhra Pradesh.
- 5. Sanction of course fee under post-metric scholarship to eligible SC / ST / LBC / EBC students studying regular / self-finance courses at postgraduate level is limited to Rs.20,000/- per year only (as per G.O.Ms. No. 56, W.W. Edn.2 Dept., Dated 6-10-2003). The extra fee over and above Rs.20,000/- has to be paid by the candidates at the time of counseling for admission. (Information provided under items 4 & 5 are subject to change as per the norms prescribed/ to be prescribed by Govt. of A.P. from time to time)
- 6. However, if the candidate does not get the sanction of the course fee amount from the Department of Social Welfare, Andhra Pradesh, he/she has to pay the prescribed course fee. The candidate has to give an undertaking at the time of admission to this effect.
- 7. Changes in admission schedule, if any, will be intimated through announcement in newspapers and electronic media and Andhra University website. Do not rely on telegrams or any other source other than the ones mentioned above, as they can be False.
- 8. Education Tours / Training Programmes / Field Works wherever prescribed are compulsory.
- 9. The candidates are required to submit declaration, duly signed by the candidate and the parent / guardian, for anti-ragging at the time of counseling,.

10. Instructions for Hostel Admission:

- a. University cannot ensure accommodation to all students admitted into PG Courses due to limited availability of rooms in both girls and boys hostels.
- b. Students seeking admission into hostels have to bring 5 copies of passport size photos and 2 sets of photocopies of TC, Caste and Income certificates along with the prescribed fee.
- c. Hostel admission will be made by chief wardens of the respective hostels of the concerned Universities subject to availability and as per their rules & regulations in force.
- d. Students are advised to go through the rules and regulations of the Hostels before applying for Hostel admission.
- e. Hostel fee structure and admission regulations are placed on the websites of the respective Universities.
- 11. Course Fee particulars along with details of distribution of seats will be placed in the Andhra University website.
